
WHEREAS the Van Buren County Water Association has received an environmental grant from The Wal-Mart Stores in the amount of \$10,000.00; and

WHEREAS, there is a critical need to place additional funds in the general account


THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF VAN BUREN COUNTY THAT:
