BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF THE COUNTY OF VAN BUREN, STATE OF ARKANSAS; AN ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED:

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE LEASE AGREEMENT OF VAN BUREN COUNTY MEMORIAL MEDICAL CENTER TO OZARK HEALTH, INC. AND PRESCRIBING OTHER MATTERS RELATING THERETO.

WHEREAS, Van Buren County presently owns a hospital facility known as Ozark Health, Inc. (the "Existing Hospital") and a nursing home facility known as Ozark Health Nursing Center (the "Existing Nursing Home") both of which are currently leased to Ozark Health, Inc. pursuant to an Amended Lease Agreement dated December 21, 1995 (the "1995 Lease"); and

WHEREAS, effective Oct 24 2000 Van Buren County has instituted a one percent (1%) sales tax for the purpose of constructing and equipping a new hospital facility (the "New Hospital") and nursing home facility (the "New Nursing Home") in the County; and

WHEREAS, upon completion of the New Hospital and the New Nursing home, the County and Ozark Health, Inc. intend to terminate the "1995 Lease"; and

WHEREAS, Van Buren County intends to transfer all of the operations and tangible personal property used in the operation of the Existing Hospital to the New Hospital upon completion of construction of the New Hospital; and

WHEREAS, Van Buren County intends to transfer all of the operations and tangible personal property used in the operation of the Existing Nursing Home to the New Nursing Home upon completion of construction of the New Nursing Home; and

WHEREAS, the Quorum Court has determined that significant benefits will accrue to the citizens of Van Buren County from leasing the New Hospital and the New Nursing Home to Ozark Health, Inc.; and

WHEREAS the Quorum Court desires to lease the New Hospital and New Nursing Home to Ozark Health, Inc. under an arrangement whereby Ozark Health, Inc. will operate the New Hospital and the New Nursing Home as nonprofit facilities to residents of and visitors to, the County; and

WHEREAS, the Quorum Court has determined that certain significant benefits will accrue to the citizens of the County if this Agreement is entered into and performed; and

WHEREAS, the Quorum Court and Ozark Health desire that the operations of the Existing Hospital and the Existing Nursing Home be transferred as a going concern, and that such transfer take place with a minimum of disruption; and

WHEREAS, the Quorum Court has determined that such Lease Agreement would provide for an orderly transition of control of the hospital; assure continued local control of the hospital; relieve the County of substantial financial obligations; increase financing and operating options open to the hospital; allow expansion of health related activities other than inpatient care; and result in other benefits not mentioned here to the Citizens of Van Buren County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF VAN BUREN COUNTY, ARKANSAS:

Article 1. The Lease Agreement for the hospital between Van Buren County, as Lessor and Ozark Health, Inc. as Lessee, attached hereto as Exhibit A, is hereby approved and the County Judge is authorized to execute and the County Clerk authorized to attest the execution of said Agreement.

Article 2. All ordinances and resolutions or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Article 3. The County Clerk is hereby instructed to publish this Ordinance within seven days after its adoption and approval.
