VAN BUREN COUNTY QUORUM COURT
EMERGENCY ORDINANCE NO. 2004-27

BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF THE COUNTY OF VAN BUREN, STATE OF ARKANSAS, AND EMERGENCY ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED:

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE ORIGINAL EMERGENCY ORDINANCE #2003-42, AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING ANIMAL CONTROL WITHIN VAN BUREN COUNTY, ARKANSAS, ESTABLISHING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Van Buren County Emergency Ordinance 2003-42, Section 5 reads as follows: Any animal which has bitten a person is a rabies suspect and such animal shall be immediately released by the owner or harbinger for quarantine confinement at the Animal Control Shelter of the County or within an enclosure approved by the Animal Control Officer for a period of ten (10) days. When any animal has bitten, scratched, or otherwise attacked a person, the person or anyone having knowledge of such incident shall immediately notify the Animal Control Officer and the County Sanitarian. The animal shall be examined by a veterinarian, and vaccinated prior to release. The animal may be quarantined at the expense of the owner, or ownership may be relinquished and the animal euthanized and its head taken to the State Health Department for pathological examination. The owner shall be responsible for the cost of euthanasia, transportation of the head and disposal of the body of the animal, and

WHEREAS, Van Buren County Emergency Ordinance 2003-42, Section 7, subsection (B) reads as follows: An owner or harbinger of an impounded animal shelter shall pay a fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) plus ten dollars (\$10.00) maintenance for each day the animal has been impounded. For each subsequent impound occurring within twelve (12) months the initial fee is doubled. After the third (3rd) violation within twelve (12) months and 5 days written notice the animal will be altered at the owner's expense by a licensed veterinarian chosen by the impounding agency before being returned to the owner or harbinger.

WHEREAS, Van Buren County Emergency Ordinance 2003-42, Section 8 reads as follows: If an owner of an unwanted animal is unable to find a suitable home or dispose of his animal through legal channels, ownership of the animal may be relinquished to the animal control authority at the discretion of the animal control authority. The donation requested for interim maintenance shall be ten dollars (\$10.00) for animals over three (3) months old and three dollars (\$3.00) for animals under three (3) months. Said animals will then be subject to the rules of the animal control authority and may be adopted out or destroyed as they deem proper.

WHEREAS, Van Buren County Emergency Ordinance 2003-42, Section 9

subsection (1) reads as follows: Payment of a ten dollar (\$10.00) adoption fee and any vaccination, licensing if applicable, or veterinary costs; and

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED:

Section 1. That Emergency Ordinance Number 2003-42, is hereby amended; and

Section 2. That Section 5 of Emergency Ordinance No. 2003-42 shall read as follows: Any animal which has bitten a person is a rabies suspect and such animal shall be immediately released by the owner or harbinger for quarantine confinement at the Animal Control of the County or within an enclosure approved by the Animal Control Officer for a period of ten (10) days. When any animal has bitten, scratched, or otherwise attacked a person, the person or anyone having knowledge of such incident shall immediately notify the Animal Control Officer and the County Sanitarian. The animal shall be examined by a veterinarian, and vaccinated prior to release. The animal may be quarantined at the expense of the owner, or ownership may be relinquished and the animal euthanized and its head taken to the State Health Department for pathological examination. The owner shall be responsible for the cost of quarantined impoundment, daily care or fee, euthanasia, transportation of the head and disposal of the body of the animal; and


Section 3. That Section 7 subsection (B) of Emergency Ordinance No. 2003-42 shall read as follows: An owner or harbinger of an impounded animal shelter shall pay a fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) plus ten dollars (\$10.00) maintenance for each day the animal has been impounded (small animal, e.g. canine or feline). The fee for large animals impoundment is \$100.00 with a \$20.00 maintenance for each day with the transport charge. For each subsequent impound occurring within twelve (12) months the initial fee is doubled. After the third (3rd) violation within twelve (12) months and 5 days written notice the animal will be altered at the owner's expense by a licensed veterinarian chosen by the impounding agency before being returned to the owner or harbinger.


Section 4. That Section 8 of Emergency Ordinance No. 2003-42 shall read as follows: If an owner of an unwanted animal is unable to find a suitable home or dispose of his animal through legal channels, ownership of the animal may be relinquished to the animal control authority at the discretion of the animal control authority. The amount requested for interim maintenance shall be ten dollars (\$10.00) for small animals over three (3) months old, three dollars (\$3.00) for animals under three (3) months, and twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) for large animals. Said animals will then be subject to the rules of the animal control authority and may be adopted out or destroyed as they deem proper.

Section 5. That Section 9 subsection (1) of Emergency Ordinance No. 2003-42 shall read as follows: Payment of a ten dollar (\$10.00) adoption fee for a feline, a fifteen dollar (\$15.00) adoption fee for a canine or any other small animal, or a fifty (\$50.00) adoption fee for a large animal, and any vaccination, licensing if applicable, or veterinary costs.

Section 6. The adoption of this Ordinance is necessary for the proper and efficient administration of the Van Buren County Animal Control Shelter and for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of Van Buren County, Arkansas; therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.





