Section 1. That Ordinance No. 2004-54, the annual operating budget for 2005 is hereby amended; and







APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE NO. 2005- 46

BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF THE COUNTY OF VAN BUREN, STATE OF ARKANSAS, AN ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED:

AN ORDINANCE DETERMINING THE DISTRIBUTION OF FUNDS RECEIVED UNDER ARKANSAS CODE ANNOTATED 6-16-1101 FOR FISH AND WILDLIFE CONSERVATION EDUCATION; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED:

Section 1. **AFFIRMATION.** This Court recognizes that pursuant to Arkansas Code Annotated 15-41-209 fine monies deposited as special revenues in the County General Fund may be expended in the form of grants for education programs for fish and wildlife conservation and other purposes consistent with Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 35. Periodically the Department of Education will disburse those monies to the county where the Game and Fish Commission fines were collected. This Court also affirms that Arkansas Code Annotated 6-16-1101 requires Van Buren County to distribute all of the funds to the Education conservation district and / or school districts within the county. The Department of Education defines that a school district shall be within the county where the primary administrative office is located.

Section 2. **DISPOSITION.** The Fish and Wildlife Conservation Funds received by Van Buren County as a result of Arkansas Code Annotated 6-16-1101 shall be deposited in the County General Fund. The County Treasurer shall distribute said funds in accordance with the following formula: Twenty-five percent (25%) of the total shall be distributed to the Van Buren County Conservation District and the remaining seventy-five (75%) shall be distributed to the school districts administered within Van Buren County based on the most recently reported ADM (average daily membership).


Section 3. **LEGISLATIVE INTENT.** It is the intent of the Van Buren County Quorum Court that all funds distributed by the authority of this Ordinance to any eligible entity be used for educational programs that meet conservation education criteria as approved by the Arkansas Department of Education. It is also the intent of this Court that the County Treasurer disburse said funds each year as soon as practical after receipt.


Section 4. **Repealer.** This ordinance hereby amends and supersedes any and all ordinances in conflict herewith, and specifically repeals Ordinance No. 2004-53 of the Quorum Court of Van Buren County, Arkansas.

Section 4. **EMERGENCY CLAUSE FOR 2005 FUNDS.** It is found and determined by the Van Buren County Quorum Court that Fish and Wildlife Conservation Funds need to be disbursed upon receipt to facilitate conservation education. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after

the date of its passage and approval.

WHEREAS: there has been presented to the Quorum Court of Van Buren County, Arkansas, the proposal of a promissory note (loan) between Van Buren County and First Service Bank of Clinton, Arkansas (lender), (under Arkansas Code Title 14-78-103 Annotated and Amendment 78 to the Arkansas Constitution of 1874), for the purpose of purchasing the office building for the Van Buren County Deputy Prosecuting Attorney's office and for remodeling the Specialty Clinic building to become the Arkansas Revenue Department Office.

THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED

Section 1: The execution and delivery of the Promissory Note, providing the financial in the principal amount not to exceed \$165,000.000 for a term of (5) years.

Section 2: That County Judge and County Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to negotiate the terms of the Promissory Note in compliance with the terms approved herein, and to execute and acknowledge such Note. That the County Judge and the County Clerk are authorized and directed to cause the Promissory Note to be accepted, executed and acknowledged by the Lender. That the County Judge is hereby authorized to confer with Lender in order to complete the Promissory Note in accordance with the terms approved herein. Execution shall constitute conclusive evidence of approval.

Section 3: That the County Judge and County Clerk are authorized and directed, all in accordance with the powers of their respective officers, to do any and all things necessary to effect the execution and delivery of the Note, the performance of all obligations of the County there-under, and the performance of all acts of whatever nature necessary to effect and carry out the authority conferred hereby. The County Judge is further authorized to execute all papers, documents, certificates, and other instruments that required for the carrying out of such authority or to evidence the exercise thereof:

Section 4: A copy of the Loan shall remain on file in the Office of the County Clerk, where it shall be available for inspection by any person.

Section 5: The provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable. In the event any section, provision or part thereof shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this Ordinance.

Section 6: There is an immediate need to arrange for the borrowing of funds from First Service Bank of Clinton, Arkansas in order to complete construction. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this Ordinance being necessary from and after its passage.






