

VAN BUREN COUNTY QUORUM COURT
ORDINANCE NO. 2011-14

BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF THE COUNTY OF VAN BUREN,
STATE OF ARKANSAS, AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED:

AN ORDINANCE THAT ESTABLISHES A VAN BUREN COUNTY
ROAD COMMITTEE WHICH WILL MONITOR ROAD FINANCES,
PLANS, AND EQUIPMENT NEEDS.

WHEREAS: There is a need for the periodic tracking of how well Van Buren County is following Road Finances, Plans and Equipment needs; and

WHEREAS: The County Judge has the authority to appoint members to committees.


THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED:

Section 1. That a Van Buren County Road Committee is established which will consist of no more than five (5) members appointed annually by the Van Buren County Judge.

Section 2. That said committee shall meet at least four (4) times annually to review road finances, plans, and equipment need status of Van Buren County. Regarding how well the department is following their budgets and if there is a need to make corrections. If any exist, to make recommendations for such corrections to the Quorum Court and the Van Buren County Judge.
