ORDINANCE NO. 2012-6

BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF THE COUNTY OF VAN BUREN,
STATE OF ARKANSAS, AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED:

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE TO PLACE ON THE NEXT BALLOT TO
BE VOTED UPON BY THE PEOPLE OF VAN BUREN COUNTY, THE
ISSUE OF SEPARATING THE OFFICE OF COUNTY/CIRCUIT CLERK.

WHEREAS: That this issue shall be placed on the next General Election ballot to be voted upon by people of Van Buren County on November 6, 2012, so as to provide for its adoption.


WHEREAS: That this separation shall take effect subsequent to the election being held on this issue and shall take force and effect from January 1, 2013.

WHEREAS: That the County Clerk shall be named and appointed by majority vote of the Van Buren County Quorum Court, which appointee shall serve a term of two (2) years, with his/her successor to be determined at the General Election to be held every two years, the first election for the Office of County Clerk to be held in November of 2014.

WHEREAS: It is hereby declared and determined by the Van Buren County Quorum Court that in order to place this issue on the ballot for the November general election an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
