BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF THE COUNTY OF VAN BUREN, STATE OF ARKANSAS, AN APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED:

AN APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE ORIGINAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE #2013-21, THE ANNUAL OPERATING BUDGET FOR 2014 IN ORDER TO INCREASE THE PROJECTED REVENUE BY \$8,360.00 AND APPROPRIATE SAID AMOUNT INTO THE SECURITY AND EMERGENCY PREPARENESS GRANT FUND #3401.

WHEREAS: Van Buren County has been awarded \$8,360.00 from the Arkansas Supreme Court's Office of Security and Emergency Preparedness for security upgrades; and

WHEREAS: There is a need and necessity to appropriate these funds in order purchase the closed-circuit television system, including 24 cameras.

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 2013-21, the annual operating budget for 2014 is hereby amended; and

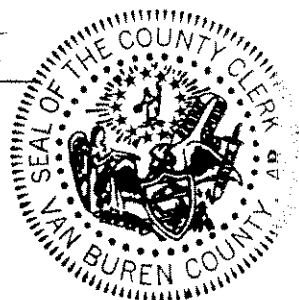

2014 Grant Program Terms and Conditions**

The Arkansas Supreme Court Committee on Security and Emergency Preparedness has awarded the county a grant in the amount of the enclosed warrant.

These funds have been awarded based upon the application that the county submitted and the funds may only be used for the purposes stated in the approved application. Equipment purchased with grant funds must be utilized in and for the courthouse or for personnel performing court security related services as described in the application.

Decisions to utilize grant funds should be approved by the Local Security and Emergency Preparedness Committee. Funds may be used to pay for costs directly or to reimburse the city or county for authorized costs which were otherwise incurred.

All grant funds must be expended by December 31, 2014.

A grant report will be required and due by January 15, 2015.

All previous funds including this award must be expended and reported by January 15, 2015.
