*WHEREAS, there is a great need for the Conway County Office of Emergency Management (OEM) and the Van Buren County Office of Emergency Management (OEM) to cooperate together for better and more efficient emergency and disaster response capabilities for the two counties; and*

*WHEREAS, both the Conway County OEM and the Van Buren County OEM in the absence of a mutual aid agreement has no authority or jurisdiction outside their county; and*

*WHEREAS, life and property can be saved by this agreement:*

*NOW THEREFORE, this agreement is entered into by the Conway County OEM and the Van Buren County Office of Emergency Management. It is to permit calling for the assistance of the other in emergency and disaster response operations on the following terms and conditions.*

*FIRST, each County Quorum Court has passed a Resolution approving the terms of this agreement and authorizing the respective County Judge and County OEM Director to sign this agreement.*

*By this agreement, both the Conway County Office of Emergency Management and Van Buren County Office of Emergency Management make a good-faith commitment to aid and assist each other.*

*SECOND, this agreement is subject to cancellation on the first of any month after giving or receiving 30 days notice of cancellation.*

**A RESOLUTION SEEKING REMOVAL OF ALL EXTRAORDINARY RESOURCE  
WATER DESIGNATIONS IN VAN BUREN COUNTY, ARKANSAS.**

WHEREAS, the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality is currently conducting a triennial review and revision of Regulation 2- Regulation Establishing Water Quality Standards for Surface Waters of the State of Arkansas, henceforth Regulation 2; and

WHEREAS, Regulation 2 provides for the establishment and/or removal of designated uses, including the Extraordinary Resource Water designations;

WHEREAS, the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality and the Arkansas Pollution Control and Ecology Commission imposed said Extraordinary Resource Water designations in Van Buren County, Arkansas, without knowledge, consent, or cooperation of the local governments, in violation of the Federal Clean Water Act; and

WHEREAS, the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality and the Arkansas Pollution Control and Ecology Commission imposed said Extraordinary Resource Water designations in Van Buren County, Arkansas, without the necessary economic and social impact studies, in violation of the Federal Clean Water Act; and

WHEREAS, the Quorum Court of Van Buren County, Arkansas, is concerned about the negative impacts the Extraordinary Resource Water designations may bring to the economy and culture of Van Buren County and its citizens and local governments;

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF VAN  
BUREN COUNTY THAT:**

Section 1: The Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality recommend that the Arkansas Pollution Control and Ecology Commission amend and revise Regulation 2, by removing all Extraordinary Resource Water designations in Van Buren County, Arkansas.
