A RESOLUTION TO BE ENTITLED:

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE COUNTY JUDGE AND TRANSFER STATION
MANAGER TO INCREASE THE TIPPING FEE OF \$40.00 TO \$43.00.**

WHEREAS, the Budget Committee in reviewing the revenue and expense projections for 2005 has observed that the current tipping fee of \$40.00 per ton is insufficient to pay the operation expenses of the Transfer Station; and


WHEREAS, the 2005 operation costs for the Transfer Station are projected to exceed the projected revenues by a little less than \$3.00 per ton of refuse received; and

WHEREAS, it appears that the tipping fee should be increased from \$40.00 per ton to \$43.00 per ton in order to cover operation expenses and reduce the likelihood that the transfer station would need to receive additional financial support from County General Funds;

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF VAN
BUREN COUNTY THAT:**

To support the County Judge and the Transfer Station Manager in their administrative decision to increase the solid waste tipping fee from \$40.00 to \$43.00.
