**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF THE COUNTY OF VAN BUREN,
STATE OF ARKANSAS, A RESOLUTION TO BE ENTITLED:**

**A RESOLUTION CHOOSING CERTAIN VOTING EQUIPMENT IN VAN
BUREN COUNTY, ARKANSAS.**

WHEREAS: Arkansas Code Annotated 7-5-301 (a) requires the Quorum Court to adopt a resolution choosing the voting system to be used in elections in Van Buren County; and

WHEREAS: the Secretary of State of the State of Arkansas has selected certain voting equipment pursuant to Arkansas Code Annotated 7-5-301 (a); and

WHEREAS: the following voting system best meets the needs of Van Buren County in conducting its elections:

1. 1 VOTRONIC ADA
2. VOTING MACHINE , NES
3. ELECTRONIC VOTE TABULATING DEVICE
FOR COUNTING ABSENTEE BALLOTS


**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF VAN BUREN
COUNTY, ARKANSAS:**

ARTICLE 1. That it chooses, pursuant to Arkansas Code Annotated 7-5-301 (a) to use the stated voting equipment as set out above.

ARTICLE 2. The chosen voting equipment is to be in place as soon as possible for use in elections in Van Buren County as provided by law.

Pursuant to ACA 7-5-301(a) Arkansas Secretary of State Charlie Daniels hereby selects the following voting equipment for use in Arkansas's counties:

1. **Voting Machines**
 - a. Direct Recording Electronic devices—Election Systems and Software iVotronic voter terminal version 6.1.2 and higher;
 - b. Danaher Shouptronic 1242 voter terminal versions as used in Columbia, Union and Ouachita counties.

2. **Voting Machines Accessible to Voters with Disabilities**
 - a. Election Systems and Software iVotronic ADA terminal version 6.1.2 and higher.

3. **Electronic Vote Tabulation Devices**
 - a. Election Systems and Software Model 100 Optical Scanner version 4.8.0.0 and higher;
 - b. Election Systems and Software Model 650 High speed optical scanner version 1.1.9.1 and higher.

4. **Other Devices**
 - a. Any voting machine, accessible voting machine or electronic vote tabulation device currently in use by any county may be used in any election prior to the acquisition and installation of voting machines, accessible voting machines or electronic vote tabulation devices selected in paragraphs (1), (2) or (3) above, except no such voting machines, accessible voting machines or electronic vote tabulation devices shall be used after November 7, 2006.

Instructions for Model Resolution

Arkansas Code Annotated 7-5-301 provides that each county choose the type of voting system it will use in future elections. That choice is limited to equipment selected by the Secretary of State. Pursuant to the statute, the Secretary of State has selected certain equipment to be chosen by the counties. The selected equipment appears on the list that accompanies this form.

Please note that Items b, c and d on the selection list under "1. Voting Machines" describe legacy equipment and can only be selected in counties where that equipment is currently in use. Also, please note that the items allowed under "4. Other Equipment" do not include punch card or lever machines, as they are not voting machines or electronic tabulating devices as those pieces of equipment are defined in the current Arkansas Code (7-1-101).

If a particular county decides to use this form, the blanks under the third "WHEREAS" should be filled in as follows:

- (1) the county's choice of voting machines accessible to voters with disabilities (Ivotronic ADA) or legacy equipment, if applicable should be listed in the first space;
- (2) if the county plans to use an all-DRE solution, and some DRE's in addition to the ADA DRE's are needed, then "voting machines" should be listed in the second space;
- (3) if a county has decided to have central count electronic vote tabulating devices or electronic vote tabulating devices at each polling place, then the second space should list "central count electronic tabulating device" or "electronic vote tabulating devices at each polling place";
- (4) Each county should list "electronic vote tabulating device for counting absentee ballots" in the third space.
