Reference is made to your letter requesting a traffic operations study at the intersection of Highway 65 South and Highway 124 in Van Buren County to determine if a traffic signal is warranted.

The Department has conducted a study which included a 24-hour traffic count and an on-site investigation. The study indicates that this intersection meets the warrants for a traffic signal as outlined in the <u>Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices</u>.

Our staff will be preparing an estimated cost to perform this work. You will be notified once this estimate (including right-of-way and utility adjustment costs, if any) has been completed.
