BOBBYE BENNETT EXICERSOLVED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF THE COUNTY OF VAN BUREN, STATE OF ARKANSAS, A RESOLUTION TO BE ENTITLED:

> A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY JUDGE OF VAN BUREN COUNTY TO APPLY FOR A GRANT ON BEHALF OF THE ALREAD COMMUNITY.

WHEREAS: The Quorum Court of Van Buren County has determined that the Alread Community meets eligibility requirements necessary to apply for a grant under the Arkansas Rural Community Grant Programs; and

WHEREAS: The Alread Community has presented plans for improvements to the Alread FUN Park. To resurface the ball/tennis court; resurface children's playground, rebuild horseshoe pit, paint the pavilion posts and stain the wood ceiling.

The Quorum Court of Van Buren County recognizes the need for this project, concurs with its importance and supports the Alread Community in its efforts to proceed with the same; and

The Alread Community has furnished proof that they have raised \$9,722.39 WHEREAS: through community cash and in/kind donations to be applied to the project as a local match.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF VAN BUREN COUNTY, STATE OF ARKANSAS

That the County Judge of Van Buren County is hereby authorized to submit an application of formal request to the Arkansas Rural Development Commission for purposes of securing state grant funds in the amount of \$9,722.39 to aid and assist the Alread Community in executing the proposed project described herein and that the County Judge and County Clerk of Van Buren County are further authorized to administer the grant funds for this project.

We are applying for improvements and renovations to the Alread FUN Park, which was started in 1998 with a grant from Arkansas Department of Tourism: Facilities for Underdeveloped Neighborhoods, and is located at 21432 Highway 16 West, Alread, AR. The proposed renovations will include:

- 1. resurface the children's playground with rubber mulch, rework the adjacent gardens.
- 2. resurface the basketball/tennis court area with Acrylic Resurfacer and patching court cracks & holes with Patch Binder.
- 3. rebuild the horseshoe pit area.
- 4. paint Pavilion interior posts and stain the wood ceiling.
